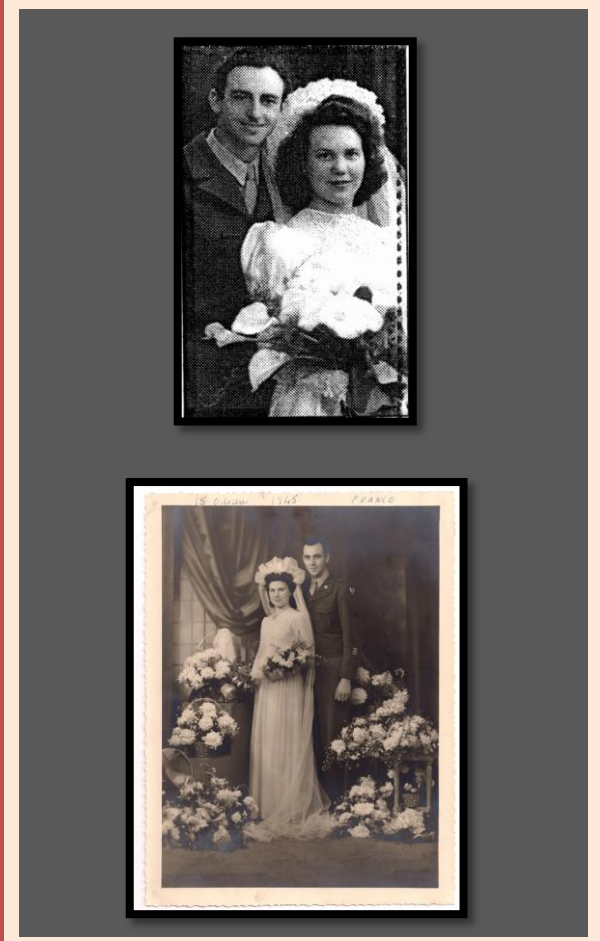

The Love Letters of WWII Project is an initiative of the nonprofit Spirit of '45 campaign, which is promoting public awareness and participation in the new national day of remembrance to honor the men and women of America's Greatest Generation. Last year, Congress voted unanimously in support of a National Spirit of '45 Day to be observed on the second Sunday of every August to coincide with the anniversary of the day President Harry S. Truman announced on August 14, 1945 that WWII was over and young couples everywhere began to look forward to a future together.

The project will officially be launched with a national press campaign on Valentine's Day 2012. The first 1,945 photos submitted will be made into a mosaic of the photograph taken in Times Square on that historic day. An enlarged version of the mosaic will be displayed in Times Square on August 14 next year.

Each couple that submits a photo will receive a free poster sized version of the mosaic, suitable for framing.

The War Brides, who married between 1941-1945 are being invited to send in their photos and short stories before the project is officially announced next February to assure that as many of them can have their photos included as possible.

Couples are encouraged to share a short story of how they met or what they remember/how they felt when they learned of the end of the war that can accompany their photo as part of a digital archive on the Spirit of '45 web site. www.Spiritof45.org

The web site will not be accepting photos for another 30 days or so, but War Brides can send them to us directly by email for now to Prisma Banners which is putting them into the collage. info@prismabanners.com

All photos will be uniformly sized to include in the Mosaic. We recommend that people send them to us at no less than 300 DPI and included name and address.
